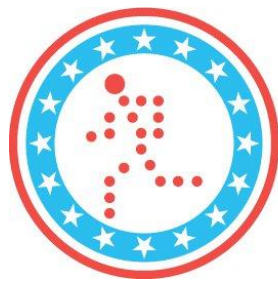
- Why:** To give individuals who are blind or visually impaired an opportunity to learn basic fundamentals and skills for participating in tandem biking.
